Graeme Rocker is Professor of Medicine at Dalhousie University and Head of the Division of Respirology in Halifax. He holds an Oxford University Doctorate for research into the Adult Respiratory Distress Syndrome and a Masters degree in Bioethics from the University of Toronto. He is the lead editor of an Oxford University Press Specialist Handbook on End-of-Life Care in the ICU and in 2009 received the Roger Bone Award from the American College of Chest physicians for advances/leadership in end-of-life care. He now leads an outreach program in Halifax (INSPIRED) for patients and families living with advanced COPD.
