PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The annual call for nominations for Fellowship in the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences will open formally on **Monday**, **January 5[™]**, **2015** with the release of letters of notification to leaders of Health Sciences Faculties across Canada. Nomination forms and guidance on preparing a Fellowship nomination form are available on our website at www.cahs-acss.ca/

This process literally determines who were are and where we are to go as an Academy. In concert with many moves by the Academy to engage our Fellows, the nomination process has been changed this year to place the onus for the nomination of new Fellows on current Fellows of the Academy.

We have been well-served in the past by reliance upon Deans, Vice Presidents of Research and other leaders of academic health sciences (often with the support of local CAHS Fellows) to take the initiative to nominate colleagues for Fellowship, and to organize letters of support, both internal and external. The Academy has now had 10 years of growth to a robust 550 Fellows – a cadre of expertise and achievement ideally qualified to bring forward new candidates.



From this year onward, we are asking YOU - as CAHS Fellows - to take the responsibility for nominating colleagues to Fellowship, to work with leaders in your institutions to generate supporting letters and to solicit the external letters essential to making the case for each nominee.

I urge each of you to give some careful thought to who among your colleagues should be honored by Fellowship in the CAHS for their scholarly achievements and leadership. Please consider those with unique competencies which will enhance our capacity to address questions of importance to the health of Canadians - and importantly - are willing to
