

John Cairns, a Professor of Medicine at UBC, is a cardiologist whose research has focused on infarct size modification, antithrombotic therapies for acute ischemic syndromes, atrial fibrillation and post-myocardial infarction arrhythmias. He has published extensively and co-edits the textbook "Evidence-Based Cardiology". He was Chair of Medicine at McMaster (1988-96) and Dean of Medicine at UBC (1996-03). He has served on the editorial boards of several peer-review journals, numerous scientific committees of peer-review agencies and professional/scientific societies. He co-chairs the Steering Committee of CANNeCTIN, a Canadian and international clinical trials network funded by CFI and CIHR. He is President-elect of CAHS.
