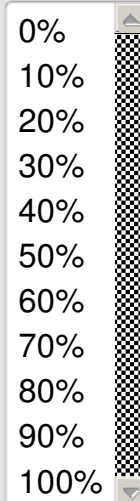

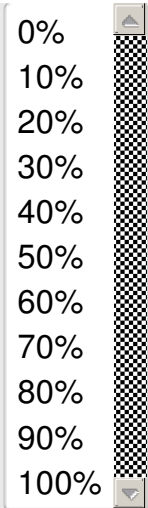

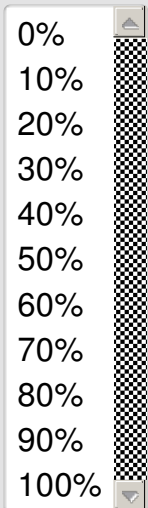
Family members of autistic individuals



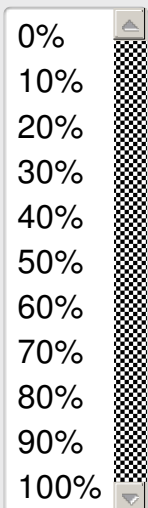
