

## Conflict of Interest and Confidentiality Agreement

## **Conflict of interest:**

It is the policy of the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences (CAHS) that the Review Committee members declare conflicts of interest with the nominees they have been asked to review while on the Committee. Conflicts of interest include:

- If the nominee is from the University or Institution, which you currently or have recently belonged to;
- If the nominee is a family member or close friend
- If you have a professional or academic relationship with the nominee (such as supervisor, colleague, co-author, etc.)

If a conflict of interest exists, the Fellowship Committee member must declare it in writing to Chris Frantz (cfrantz@cahs-acss.ca). Confirmation of the conflict of interest will be acknowledged and the Chair will be informed
